

## PBS Updates and Reminders

## Happy Friday, Hurricanes!

PBS team has gathered important information about grade-level discipline referrals to help us hone our efforts in addressing immediate areas of concern in student behavior. Although our overall referral count has increased from 7 to 23 during August 17 through September 16, this count is <a href="lower-than-it">lower</a> than it was last year. This is great news! The area of growth we should focus on for next week is classroom disruption. Remember, you can reach out to a students' guidance counselor, PBS team, and/or AIP team for additional support to provide interventions in class. Below is a breakdown of our referral count per grade level, gender, and area of focus with comparisons.
